Re: Nighttime Outside Lighting

We'd like to remind homeowners and residents that keeping exterior lights on at night gives Parkwood a warm glow and helps improve community safety. And, for venturing out at night and returning home, good lighting is always helpful.

Here are a few suggestions to improve outside lighting during the evening:

- Turn on porch lights and exterior garage lights; or add timed lighting or lights with dusk-to-dawn sensors.
- For front and rear patio areas, turn lights on; or add timed lighting or lights with motion sensors or dusk-to-dawn sensors.

Many homeowners and residents are concerned about the cost of replacing burned-out bulbs due to increased use. Please keep in mind that the association will "sponsor" those who regularly keep their porches, entryways, walkways or garages lighted at night. When your bulbs or sensors need replacing, simply submit a maintenance request form.
